

WASHING MACHINE CLEANING PROCEDURE

From time to time washing machines may build up with detergents and lint on the outside of the washer drum, where it is practically impossible to clean without disassembling the machine. When this occurs, it is common to see blotches of lint on the clean clothes. Many people have experienced success cleaning their washing machine using the following procedure:

1. Pour one gallon of white vinegar into the washing machine.
2. Fill the washing machine with hot water. You may be able to accomplish this by setting to extra large load or you may have to fill manually. It is important to fill the machine approximately $\frac{3}{4}$ full with hot water.
3. Agitate for 5 minutes then allow to soak for 1 hour.
4. Repeat step 3 two more times.
5. Now run the washer through a complete wash and rinse cycle.

Your washing machine should now be clean. It is a good practice to repeat this procedure annually or as needed to prevent undue lint blotching/staining on washed clothes.
